## After The Course

We ask all course participants to give their views after completing a course via our online evaluation survey, which takes no more than ten minutes to complete. If you don't complete the online survey within 30 days of the course, you will need to request a certificate. This involves completing a short form and paying an administration fee of £10.

### Complete the online evaluation survey

You will need to complete the online evaluation survey before you can access the certificate for your course. The link to the online survey will be emailed to you after the course, using the email address registered on the RCS website. Survey links will only be sent out once the attendance has been recorded on our system. This can take up to 72 hours so you won't receive the link immediately after the course has finished.

### Accessing the course certificate

Course certificates are available to download via your account on the RCS website. Certificates will only be created once you have completed the online evaluation survey and can then take up to 24 hours to appear on your account. To access your certificates please go to the RCS website and follow these instructions:

1. Login using the email address that they have registered with us
2. Navigate to 'My Account' by clicking on their name in the top, right hand corner
3. Follow the **course order history** link in the right hand side column
4. View or print any certificates that they have within their account. Please note that depending on browser, they may have to choose to print or save as a pdf

You won't receive a certificate if they failed the course but you should still complete the survey.
